Performance Fee

There is no fee to perform in Time To Groove. To keep it that way, we ask that you support the production by inviting your family and friends to attend, as well as donate something to our bake sale.

Tickets

Pre-sale tickets are \$12 through the month of May. You can purchase tickets at the shop/office or from your instructor. Regular price tickets are \$15 beginning June 1st. Children 2 and under are free if sitting on a lap. We do sell out. Purchase your tickets early!

Intermission Bake Sale

Our refreshments table at each intermission consists of donated items, baked goods/chips/bottled water etc.. Each item is priced \$1. Please plan to donate something. Bring your donations the day of the show and drop them off on your way in, we take care of the rest. Mark any dish needing to be returned.

Theater Information

Freedom Hall shares its parking lot with Central Park. It does fill up. The streets surrounding the facility and the library lot are available for overflow parking. ***The theater opens an hour before show time.***

Volunteers

We are looking for at least 6 volunteers for each show. Front end works the ticket booth, theater doors and refreshment table. Back stage helps keep the kids happy. Volunteers do not watch the show but they do receive a free ticket to watch the opposing performance. For example, volunteer to work the Matinee, watch the Evening performance for free. There is a sign up sheet in the studio. I will reach out to our volunteers as we get closer to show time.

Performer Information

Mandatory Tech Rehearsal - Friday June 7th ~ Schedule to follow

This is a closed rehearsal. Performers only -No exceptions. The stage managers will be introduced at the dress rehearsal. All stage related questions should be directed to them. Performers are welcome to stay the entire time or leave once they are finished. The rehearsal will run as closely to the actual show as possible. The line up will be posted in the studio in the weeks to come.

Show Day

Performers are required to sign in at least 30 minutes before show time. All performers are housed upstairs in the staging rooms throughout the ***entire performance***. Staging rooms are for performers only. No family members or guests allowed. Performers must remain in the staging rooms before and after their performance. Bake Sale will be open to the performers just before and just after the intermission. ***Performers must stay in the back stage area during intermission.*** All performers will be taking place in the finale and will be released from the stage. Dancers are excused for the break between shows. Show is approximately 2.5 hours.
